Circle Time – Group games: Eye spy, swap places,

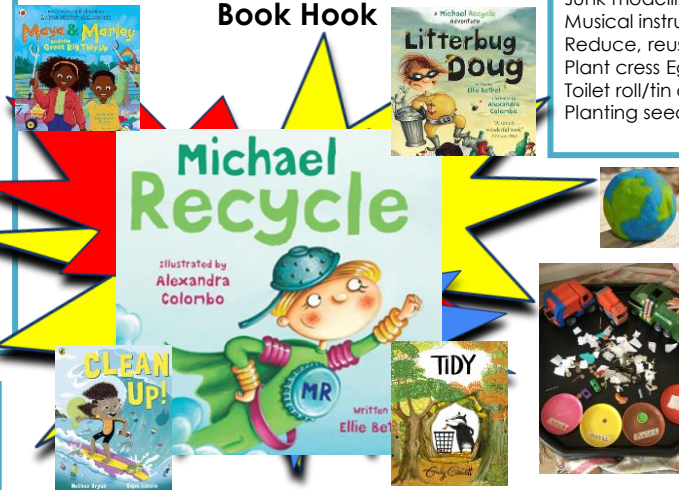
BSL – Whole school sign of the week
